Artistic Director

Jeff retired after serving 16 years at Zanesville High School as band director and music department coordinator from 1988-2004. At ZHS, he was in charge of the concert band, wind ensemble, jazz band and pep band in addition to the marching band, which had an unbroken record of 16 appearances at state finals. Previously Jeff held band director positions at Philo HS, Hamlin (WVA) HS, Fort Frye HS, and most recently Custer County HS in Westcliffe, Colorado. He Earned a Bachelors Degree at Ohio University in 1974, Masters Degree in Music Education at Marshall University in 1981, and a Masters Degree in Public School Administration at Ohio University in 1992. He has served the Ohio Music Education Association (OMEA) as district secretary/treasurer, president-elect, and president; hosting high school large group, middle school solo & ensemble, regional orchestra, local marching band, and district honor band/choir events. His professional organizations include: OMEA, American School Band Directors Association, Phi Beta Mu, Omicron Delta Kappa, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. Jeff was director of the Muskingum College Spirit Band 2004-2006. He resides in Dresden with his wife, Jennifer.

Andrew Ruetz – Conductor 2009 ZMCB Honors Band

Andrew Ruetz is the Director of Bands for the West Muskingum Local School District in Zanesville, Ohio, as well as Lecturer in Trombone at Muskingum College in New Concord, Ohio. He is a 1994 graduate of the Capital University Conservatory of Music in Columbus, Ohio. Mr. Ruetz is a member of the Muskingum College Faculty Brass Quintet and the Tuscarawas Philharmonic Orchestra and has also played with the Dick Simcox Jazz Band, Muskingum Valley Symphonic Winds, Southeastern Ohio Symphony Orchestra, Zanesville Memorial Concert Band, Coshocton Community Band, and is a founding member of the Slidin' Along Trombone Quartet. He currently serves the Ohio Music Education Association as District 9 Secretary/Treasurer and as chair the for the OMEA District 9 Junior High Solo & Ensemble Adjudicated Event.

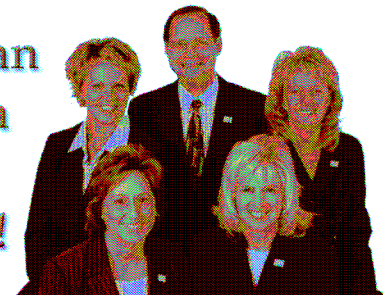

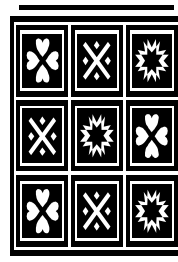
