In addition to Secrest Auditorium, the Y-City Barbershoppers have made recent appearances at Muskingum University's Brown Chapel, the Twin-Cities Opera House in McConnellsville, the vocal music classes at most area high schools and a number of senior citizen facilities.

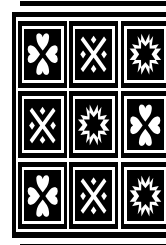
