The ZMCB – A Brief History

Zanesville flourished with performing arts activities in the late 1800s, and the John Bauer Band was among them. The band was organized before 1880 and averaged 15 to 20 members. When the band leader died in 1912, his ensemble was taken over by the American Rolling Mills Company, and became known as the Armco Band.

The 7th Regiment Band was formed in 1900, conducted by Bruce Tomlinson. Four years later, band members began federal service in advent of war.

The 7th Regiment and Armco bands held their concerts locally, in McIntire Park and Putnam Park. By 1923, the two bands had merged, taking the present day name of Zanesville Memorial Concert Band.

Today, funds for the concerts are raised by individual and corporate contributions. An endowment fund has also been established for anyone wishing to make a donation towards the ZMCB.

The band's current home is Zane's Landing Park, along the eastern banks of the Muskingum River in downtown Zanesville. Concerts are performed on five Sunday evenings through the summer.

Concerts remain free to the public, thanks to the generosity of our supporters.

Dr. Gene Milford

Guest Conductor

Gene Milford, a native of Canton, is a Senior Lecturer in Music Education at the University of Akron. He has also served on the faculty of Kent State University and Hiram College. He holds degrees from Kent State, including a Masters of Arts in Music History and a Ph.D. in Music Education. A public school instrumental music educator with 30 years of experience, his ensembles consistently received superior ratings at adjudicated events and performed at state and national professional conferences. Dr. Milford has served as guest conductor, clinician, and adjudicator, and presented clinic sessions at regional and national conferences. His articles on music education have appeared in Triad, The Instrumentalist, Dialogues in Instrumental Music Education, and Contributions to Music Education. As a composer and arranger, he has received numerous commissions, grants and awards, and has more than 70 published works for band, orchestra, choir, and small ensembles. His professional affiliations include the Ohio Music Education Association (for which he has served as a district president and on numerous committees at both the district and state levels), American School Band Directors Association (having served as state chair), National Band Association, Phi Beta Mu, Phi Kappa Lambda, and the American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers. He has received the ASCAP Plus Award each year since 2001. Dr. Milford was the 2006 inductee to the Ohio Band Directors Hall of Fame.



Jeffrey L. Roquemore

Artistic Director

Jeff retired from Zanesville High School after serving 16 years as band director and music department coordinator from 1988-2004. Previously, Jeff held band director positions at Philo High School, Hamlin (W.Va.) High School, Fort Frye High School, and, most recently, Custer County High School in Westcliffe, Colo. Jeff earned a Bachelor's Degree from Ohio University in 1974, a Master's Degree in Music Education from Marshall University in 1981, and a Master's Degree in Public School Administration from Ohio University in 1992. He has served the Ohio Music Education Association (OMEA) as district secretary-treasurer, president-elect, and president. Jeff was also director of the Muskingum College Spirit Band from 2004-06. He also plays flute and piccolo for the band.

Janine Schmelzer Bock

Assistant Conductor

Mrs. Schmelzer Bock is a native of Bremen, Ohio, and received her Bachelor of Music Education and Master of the Arts degrees from Ohio State University. As a member of the Ohio State University Marching Band, she became the first woman to dot the "i" in the famed "Script Ohio" marching maneuver in a single-script at a home football game in Ohio Stadium. Schmelzer Bock also has been a member of the 122nd Army Band / Army National Guard, stationed at Beitler Armory in Worthington. When not wielding the baton in front of the ZMCB, you will find her playing tuba for the band.
