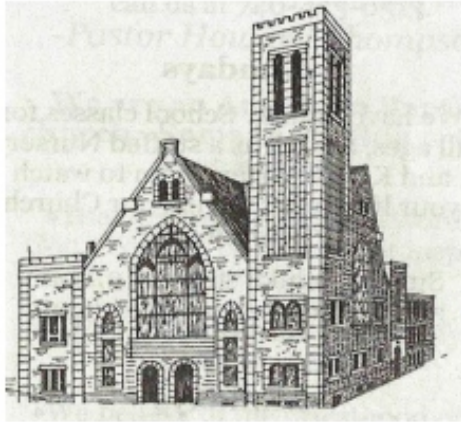

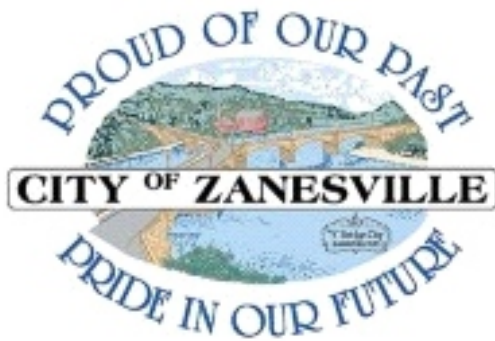

MEET OUR ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

Dr. David A. Turrill

Dr. David A. Turrill has served as the Artistic Director of the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band since 2019. He is currently Associate Professor of Music and Director of Bands at Muskingum University and also serves as Faculty Coordinator of the First Year Experience. He teaches courses in music education, conducting, music theory, and applied trumpet, in addition to supervising student teachers.

A native of Marietta, Ohio, he earned a Bachelor of Music in music education from Ohio University; a Master of Music in conducting and trumpet performance from Ohio University; and a Doctor of Musical Arts in trumpet performance, with a cognate in wind conducting, from Michigan State University. Prior to joining the faculty at Muskingum, Dr. Turrill taught at Spring Arbor University (MI) and enjoyed twelve years of public-school teaching in southeast Ohio. Bands under his direction consistently earned superior ratings at regional and state adjudicated events. He is passionate about new repertoire for Wind Ensemble and has been involved in the commissioning of several works by leading composers, including Brian Balmages, Ryan Nowlin, John Mackey, Jake Runestad, Donald Grantham, and Giovanni Santos.

Dr. Turrill's professional affiliations include membership in Pi Kappa Lambda music honor society, College Band Directors National Association, National Association for Music Education, Ohio Music Education Association, International Trumpet Guild, Ohio Private College Instrumental Conductors Association, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. Dr. Turrill is active as a band clinician for high schools in the region and has presented at state professional development conferences in Ohio and Iowa.

Movement on Main Center for Dance

Founded by Director Whitney Lewis in 2010, Movement on Main offers dance classes to children and adults with the goal to promote dance with artistry and integrity to the local community. Their spacious facility boasts five dance studios, dressing rooms, and waiting rooms with studio viewing windows. Movement on Main offers dance instruction year-round through structured classes that culminate in a production themed recital. With mentored and trained instructors, the mission of Movement on Main is to inspire students through progressive, curriculum-based classes, and compassionate instruction. Dancers have the opportunity to build their community, boost their confidence, and expand their creativity through the art of dance.

The choreography for today's concert was created by Peter Merz (*At a Dixieland Jazz Funeral*) and his daughter Lucy Merz (*Belle of the Ball*). Peter has choreographed over 40 original ballets across the United States and internationally. His award-winning choreography relies heavily on his background in classical ballet but is informed by his passion for contemporary dance forms. Lucy is a professional ballet dancer with the Indianapolis Ballet, where she is also a faculty member. Lucy has created two original ballets for the Indianapolis Ballet's New Work Series and has also served as a teacher for the American Dance Competition.

JOHN CLIMER
GUEST CONDUCTOR

John Climer served as Director of Bands and Professor of Music at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee's Peck School of the Arts from 2008 until his retirement in 2022. Prior to his appointment in Milwaukee, John was Director of Bands at Ohio University where he conducted the Wind Ensemble and led the graduate program in wind conducting. After a short retirement, he moved back to Ohio and served as Interim Director of Wind Ensembles at Capital University where he also conducted the Columbus Youth Symphonic Band.

As a guest conductor and clinician, he has led performances at festivals, universities, and concert venues nationally and internationally including the Midwest Band and Orchestra Clinic, the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, the Eastman School of Music, and the Conservatorio di Musica G. Martucci in Salerno, Italy. Ensembles under his direction have performed for four conferences of the College Band Directors National Association (CBDNA), including the 2013 National Conference in Greensboro, North Carolina. In July of 2015, the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee Wind Ensemble was selected to perform for the 16th International Conference of the World Association for Symphonic Bands and Ensembles (WASBE) in San Jose, CA.

John is the recipient of three university teaching awards and in 2021, he was recognized by Phi Beta Mu as Wisconsin's Bandmaster of the Year. His biography is published in the third edition of *Who's Who Among America's Teachers* and he is an elected member of the American Bandmasters Association. John has failed miserably at retirement... In the fall of 2024, he will serve as an Associated Faculty member at Ohio State University where he will conduct the Symphonic Band and teach undergraduate instrument conducting.

KELLEY RYAN
ASSISTANT DIRECTOR

Mr. Kelley Ryan has served as the Assistant Director of the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band since 2016. He retired last month after completing 48 years of directing bands for the Zanesville City Schools where he taught grades 5 through 12. Mr. Ryan received a Bachelor of Music Degree from Muskingum College in 1975 and a Master of Music Degree from the University of Akron in 1980. He has also studied at the University of Virginia, Kent State University, Ohio University, Andrews University, and Ashland University. He has been an OMEA adjudicator since 1981 and served as the OMEA District IX treasurer for four years. More recently, he edited and revised the OMEA required solo lists for soprano, tenor, and baritone saxophones and for the Eb clarinet.

“Choreography: Synthesis of Music and Movement”

Music and dance are inherently intertwined, each complementing and enhancing the other in a seamless expression of artistry and emotion. At its essence, music provides the rhythmic heartbeat that drives dance, setting the pace and mood for movement. Tonight's concert, “Choreography,” explores this synergy by creating a dialogue between sound and movement that seeks to share the power to evoke deep emotions and convey narratives without words. The Memorial Band is joined by Movement on Main Center for Dance to present to you two vastly different dance works—one is a traditional ballet, rooted in European waltzes of Richard Strauss, and the other is drawn from the “second line” tradition of a New Orleans funeral procession. Each transcend cultural boundaries, allowing performers and audiences alike to connect in a primal level through rhythm, melody, and physical expression. We hope you enjoy “Choreography!”
