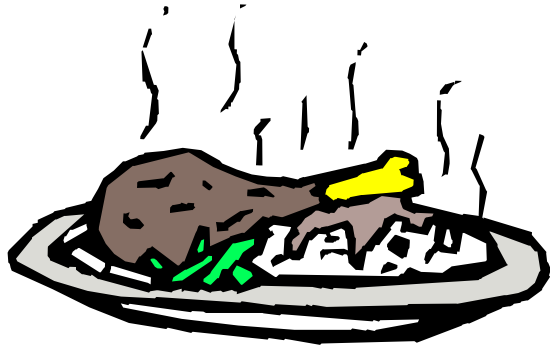

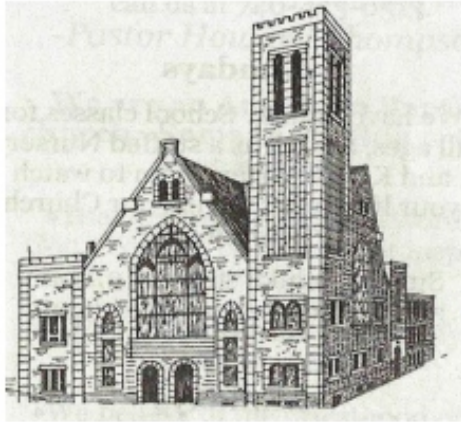

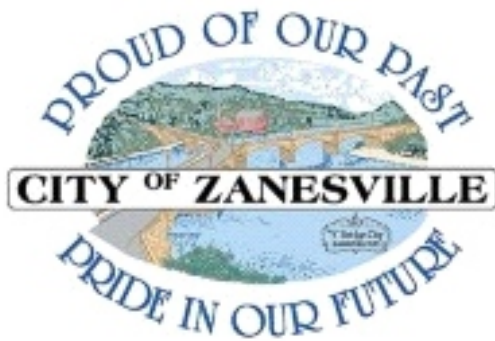

MEET OUR ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

Dr. David A. Turrill

Dr. David A. Turrill has served as the Artistic Director of the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band since 2019. He is currently Associate Professor of Music and Director of Bands at Muskingum University and also serves as Faculty Coordinator of the First Year Experience. He teaches courses in music education, conducting, music theory, and applied trumpet, in addition to supervising student teachers.

A native of Marietta, Ohio, he earned a Bachelor of Music in music education from Ohio University; a Master of Music in conducting and trumpet performance from Ohio University; and a Doctor of Musical Arts in trumpet performance, with a cognate in wind conducting, from Michigan State University. Prior to joining the faculty at Muskingum, Dr. Turrill taught at Spring Arbor University (MI) and enjoyed twelve years of public-school teaching in southeast Ohio. Bands under his direction consistently earned superior ratings at regional and state adjudicated events. He is passionate about new repertoire for Wind Ensemble and has been involved in the commissioning of several works by leading composers, including Brian Balmages, Ryan Nowlin, John Mackey, Jake Runestad, Donald Grantham, and Giovanni Santos.

Dr. Turrill's professional affiliations include membership in Pi Kappa Lambda music honor society, College Band Directors National Association, National Association for Music Education, Ohio Music Education Association, International Trumpet Guild, Ohio Private College Instrumental Conductors Association, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. Dr. Turrill is active as a band clinician for high schools in the region and has presented at state professional development conferences in Ohio and Iowa.

We honor and recognize the longest serving member of the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band, euphonium player Richard Kreuter. A native of Zanesville, Richard began his musical journey playing baritone horn at Munson Elementary School in fourth grade. He joined the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band in 1946 under the baton of conductor Paul Kern, and has been playing with the Memorial Band for 78 years!

An active community musician, he has also performed with Lakewood City Band and Newport Richie Community Band in Florida. Locally, he performs with the Cambridge City Band and the Coshocton City Band and performed with the Ohio National Guard Band for four years. In addition to his musical pursuits, Richard's interests include flying, and he built his own airplane.

Richard was married to Beatrice Wickham for 71 years, marrying her on July 2, 1947, in Kentucky while driving his Model T across state lines. They had five sons, Richard, Ronald, Robert, Randy, and Rick. He worked as a millwright at Owens Brockway Glass for 40 years and is a life-long member of the Colburn United Methodist Church.

Richard's dedication to the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band is unparalleled and is a shining example for us to follow in all our pursuits. The Memorial Band family extends our deepest gratitude and appreciation for his years of service and wish him the best in his Memorial Band retirement!

MEET OUR HONORS BAND DIRECTOR

Susan Climer

Susan Climer enjoyed 36 years as a music educator and administrator before retiring in 2022. She earned a bachelor of music education degree from Stetson University (FL), a master of music degree in clarinet performance from the University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music and a master of educational administration degree from Ohio University. Mrs. Climer taught band and general music for 21 years in Kansas, Georgia, North Dakota and Ohio, with her longest tenure as Director of Bands in the Athens City School District (OH) before becoming a school principal in Ohio and Wisconsin the last 15 years of her career. Her middle and high school bands consistently earned superior ratings at district and state level concert and marching band events. Mrs. Climer served as a band adjudicator and clinician in Ohio and West Virginia, as well as the OMEA Junior High Affairs Chair, and she is honored to conduct this year's ZMCB High School Honors Band.

MEET OUR ASSISTANT DIRECTOR

Kelley Ryan

Mr. Kelley Ryan has served as the Assistant Director of the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band since 2016. He retired last month after completing 48 years of directing bands for the Zanesville City Schools where he taught grades 5 through 12. Mr. Ryan received a Bachelor of Music Degree from Muskingum College in 1975 and a Master of Music Degree from the University of Akron in 1980. He has also studied at the University of Virginia, Kent State University, Ohio University, Andrews University, and Ashland University. He has been an OMEA adjudicator since 1981 and served as the OMEA District IX treasurer for four years. More recently, he edited and revised the OMEA required solo lists for soprano, tenor, and baritone saxophones and for the Eb clarinet.
