## The ZCMB - A Brief History

Zanesville has a long history of strong support for music and the other arts. Bands have flourished in Zanesville since 1820 when Charles Hill organized the first reed and string band, a mixed ensemble comprised of nine musicians. In 1847, Professor A.D. Atwood formed the Atwood Band, which would be reorganized a few years later and renamed the Bauer Band. Led by John Bauer, one of the most important Zanesville musicians of this era, the Bauer Band enjoyed a long and notable history which included performing for the opening of the suspension bridge in Wheeling in 1849 and traveling to St. Louis in 1891 to perform at the funeral of Ohio-born Civil War General William Sherman. When John Bauer passed away in 1912, his band was taken over by the American Rolling Mill Company and renamed the Armco Band and continued to flourish in Zanesville. Another active band during this time was the 7<sup>th</sup> Regiment Band, which served as the principal rival for the Armco Band. It was the merging of the Armco and 7<sup>th</sup> Regiment Bands in 1923 that formed the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band, which was conducted by Paul Kern. In the early days of the Memorial Band, summer concerts were held at McIntire and Putnam Parks, in addition to other locations around Zanesville. The current home of the Memorial Band is Zane's Landing Park.

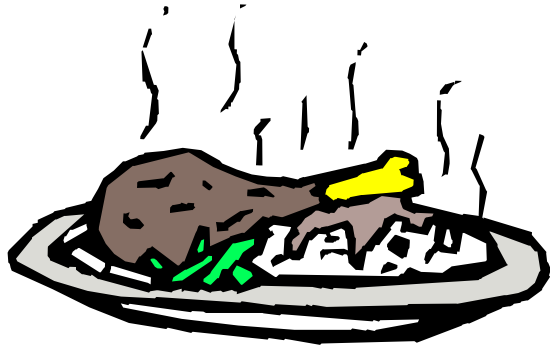

## MEET OUR ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

### **Dr. David A. Turrill**

**D**r. David A. Turrill has served as the Artistic Director of the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band since 2019. He is currently Associate Professor of Music and Director of Bands at Muskingum University, where he conducts the Muskingum University Wind Ensemble and Muskingum Valley Symphonic Winds. He also teaches courses in music education, conducting, music theory, and applied trumpet, in addition to supervising student teachers. A native of Marietta, Ohio, he earned a Bachelor of Music in music education from Ohio University; a Master of Music in conducting and trumpet performance from Ohio University; and a Doctor of Musical Arts in trumpet performance, with a cognate in wind conducting, from Michigan State University. Prior to joining the faculty at Muskingum, Dr. Turrill taught at Spring Arbor University (MI) and enjoyed twelve years of public-school teaching in southeast Ohio. Bands under his direction consistently earned superior ratings at regional and state adjudicated events. He is passionate about new repertoire for Wind Ensemble and has been involved in the commissioning of several works by leading composers, including Brian Balmages, Ryan Nowlin, John Mackey, Jake Runestad, Donald Grantham, and Giovanni Santos. Dr. Turrill's professional affiliations include membership in Pi Kappa Lambda music honor society, College Band Directors National Association, National Association for Music Education, Ohio Music Education Association, International Trumpet Guild, Ohio Private College Instrumental Conductors Association, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. Dr. Turrill is active as a band clinician for high schools in the region and has presented at state professional development conferences in Ohio and Iowa. A strong advocate for community-based music, Dr. Turrill is honored to be serving as Artistic Director during the centennial season of the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band.

## MEET OUR HONORS BAND DIRECTOR

### **Ben Factor**

**M**r. Benjamin E. Factor is currently in his sixteenth year of teaching and ninth year as Director of Bands at Lancaster High School where he directs Symphonic Band, Concert Band, Freshman Band, Swinging Gales, Pep Band, and the Band of Gold. He also assists with the Sixth, Seventh, and Eighth grade bands at both General Sherman and Thomas Ewing Junior High Schools. All bands under his direction have been rated Superior at both the local and state levels, including the school's first state Superior for the top concert band in over 20 years, and the first ever for the second concert band. A native of Grove City, Ohio, Mr. Factor attended The Ohio State University graduating magna cum laude with a bachelor's degree in Music Education in 2007. He holds a master's degree in Educational Leadership from Ohio Dominican University. Prior to his appointment at Lancaster High School, Mr. Factor was the Director of Bands for seven years at Liberty Union-Thurston Local Schools in Baltimore, Ohio. In 2007, under his direction, the Liberty Union Marching Band qualified for State Marching Band Finals for the first time ever, and earned state level superior ratings every year thereafter. The band also received fourteen consecutive "1<sup>st</sup> Place" awards, a streak spanning five seasons. In 2008, his Concert Band earned a superior rating at State Finals for the first time in nearly fifty years, and continued to receive consistent superior ratings at district and state adjudicated events throughout his entire tenure with the band program. Mr. Factor's professional memberships include Phi Beta Mu International Bandmasters Fraternity, American School Band Directors Association, National Association for Music Education, the Ohio Music Education Association, and Pi Kappa Lambda national Music Honor Society. In 2022, he was awarded the Music Education Roll of Distinction Award by The Ohio State University School of Music. Mr. Factor served as Chairperson for the 2022 OMEA All-State Jazz Band, Co-Chair of the 2014 OMEA All-State Ensembles, State Treasurer for the OMEA Board of Trustees (2014-2016), OMEA Strategic Plan Chair (2016-present), and is an OMEA Marching Band Adjudicator. He was recently elected to serve as OMEA District XV Treasurer. In addition, he has given clinics at the OMEA Professional Development Conference, The Ohio State University School of Music Student Leadership Intensive, Capital University's Complete Band Director Workshop, and at the Marching Band Adjudicator's Summer Session. Outside of School, Mr. Factor plays trombone with the Heisey Wind Ensemble and is the Director of Music at St. Mary's Church in Bremen.
