Artistic Director

Mr. Treier is a graduate of The Ohio State University with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Music Education. He retired as the director of bands at Cambridge City Schools after serving for 29 years. He was named Outstanding Music Educator in 1993 by the Ohio Music Educators Association. Max has been a member of the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band for 22 years and served as the announcer for a number of years. This is his sixth year as Artistic Director.

Dr. William Schlacks

Conductor, H.S. Honors Concert Band

Dr. William Schlacks is the chair of the department of music as well as the conductor of the Muskingum Valley Symphonic Winds, the Muskingum College Wind & Percussion Ensemble, and the Aldersgate Choir at the New Concord United Methodist Church. In addition, he teaches courses in conducting and music education. Dr. Schlacks received the Bachelor of Science in Education and Master of Music in Trumpet Performance degrees from Northern Illinois University and a Ph. D. in Music Education from the University of Miami (Florida). After his studies at Miami, he conducted the Wind Ensemble and was the coordinator of music education at Indiana University - Purdue University at Fort Wayne. During his tenure at IPFW he founded and conducted the Fort Wayne Area Community Band and received numerous awards for this endeavor including the Medal of Merit for Community Service from the City of Fort Wayne. He is a member of the Music Educators National Conference, Ohio Music Education Association, College Band Directors National Association, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia and serves as a member of the board of the Ohio Society for Music Teacher Education. He is a past president of the Ohio Private College Instrumental Conductors Association, and is Muskingum's representative to the National Association of Schools of Music where he has served as the chair for the sessions for smaller units of music, a visiting evaluator, and as a consultant. He is also a past president of the Ohio Association of Music Schools and serves on the board of the Ohio Coalition for Music Education. In 1995 he was named an Outstanding Educator by the Zanesville Chapter of Phi Delta Kappa and in April of 2005 was named the Ruth Dorsey Neptune Distinguished Professor in Fine Arts at Muskingum College. He and his wife Mary, and daughters Erin and Samantha, live in New Concord.

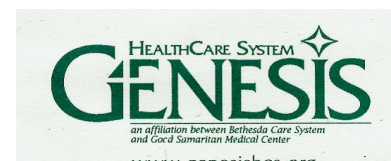

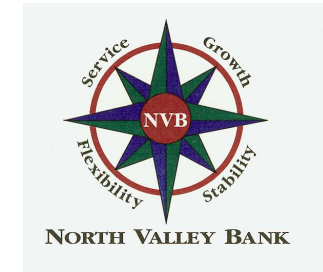
