Mr. Ryan received a Bachelor of Music Degree from Muskingum College in 1975 and a Masters of Music Degree from the University of Akron in 1980. He has also studied at The University of Virginia, Kent State University, Ohio University, Andrews University and Ashland University. He has been an OMEA Adjudicator since 1981 and served as the OMEA District 9 treasurer for four years. More recently, he edited and revised the OMEA Required Solo lists for soprano, tenor, and baritone saxophones and for the Eb clarinet.

In August, Mr. Ryan will begin his 47th year directing bands for the Zanesville City School System where he teaches grades 5 through 12.

MEET OUR HONORS BAND DIRECTOR

MEG BEAVER

Meg Beavers is a resident of Blacklick, OH and is a 2009 graduate of The Ohio State University. She has been Director of Bands at Licking Heights High School since 2013 where she is responsible for all three high school concert bands, the Licking Heights Marching Band, and the pit orchestra for the annual LH musical. She also serves as the woodwind specialist for LH students in grades 6-8. During her time at Licking Heights, the bands have consistently received high ratings at Ohio Music Education Association's (OMEA) Local and State Adjudicated Events. Prior to her position at Licking Heights, Meg spent four years as Director of Bands at Fort Recovery Local Schools in Mercer County, OH, where she was responsible for all aspects of the band program grades 5-12.

She has enjoyed serving as an OMEA Large Group, and Solo & Ensemble Adjudicator. Previously she served as the 2014 OMEA All-State Co-Coordinator and OMEA District X President. Over the last several years she has been a mentor to student teachers from The Ohio State University, Capital University and Muskingum University.

Meg was honored to receive the 2017 Licking County, "You Make a Difference Award" for Licking Heights Local Schools, and in 2014 received the Mercer County "Teacher of Influence" for Fort Recovery Local Schools.

Throughout the year, Meg performs on alto saxophone with The Heisey Wind Ensemble, and on alto horn with the Brass Band of Columbus.

In her free time, Meg enjoys spending time with family, friends and her two dogs, Mac and Molly.

MEET OUR CONDUCTORS

Dr. David A. Turrill

ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

Dr. David A. Turrill was appointed Artistic Director of the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band in 2019. He also serves as Director of Bands and Associate Professor of Music at Muskingum University, where he conducts the Muskingum University Wind Ensemble, the Muskingum Valley Symphonic Winds, and co-directs the Jazz Ensemble. His teaching responsibilities at Muskingum include teaching applied trumpet, conducting, courses in music education, and supervising student teachers. Dr. Turrill has maintained an active schedule as a guest conductor and clinician, and played trumpet in the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band from 2010 to 2018. A champion of new music, he has been involved in numerous commissioning projects, including works by composers John Mackey, Jake Runestad, Ryan Nowlin, Donald Grantham, Giovanni Santos, and Anthony Plog.

A native of Marietta, Ohio, Dr. Turrill earned the Bachelor of Music Education degree as well as Master of Music degrees in Conducting and Trumpet Performance from Ohio University. He earned the Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Trumpet Performance, with a cognate in wind conducting, from Michigan State University. Prior to his appointment at Muskingum, Dr. Turrill was on the faculty at Spring Arbor University (MI) and performed regularly with the orchestras of Lansing, Grand Rapids, West Michigan, Battle Creek, Saginaw Bay, Jackson, and Livonia.

In addition to his university teaching experience, Dr. Turrill also has twelve years of public-school teaching experience as an elementary, middle school, and high school band director. His middle school and high school bands consistently earned superior ratings at regional and state adjudicated events. Dr. Turrill's professional affiliations include membership in Pi Kappa Lambda music honor society, the College Band Directors National Association, the National Association for Music Education, the Ohio Music Education Association, International Trumpet Guild, the Ohio Private College Instrumental Conductors Association, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia.

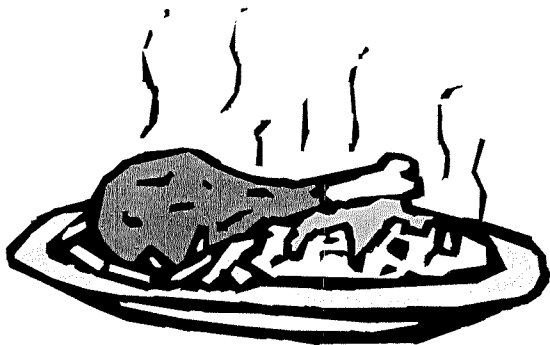

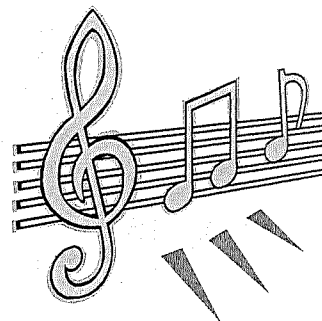

The ZCMB - A Brief History

Zanesville flourished with performing arts activities in the late 1800's, and the John Bauer Band was among them. The band was organized before 1800 and averaged 15 to 20 members. When the band leader died in 1912, his ensemble was taken over by the American Rolling Mills Company and became known as the Armco Band.

The 7th Regiment and Armco bands held their concerts locally, in McIntire Park and Putnam Park. By 1923, the two bands had merged, taking the present day name of Zanesville Memorial Concert Band.

Today, funds for the concerts are raised by individual and corporate contributions. An endowment fund has also been established for anyone wishing to make a donation towards the ZMCB.

The band's current home is Zane's Landing Park, along the eastern banks of the Muskingum River in downtown Zanesville. Concerts are performed on five Sunday evenings through the summer.

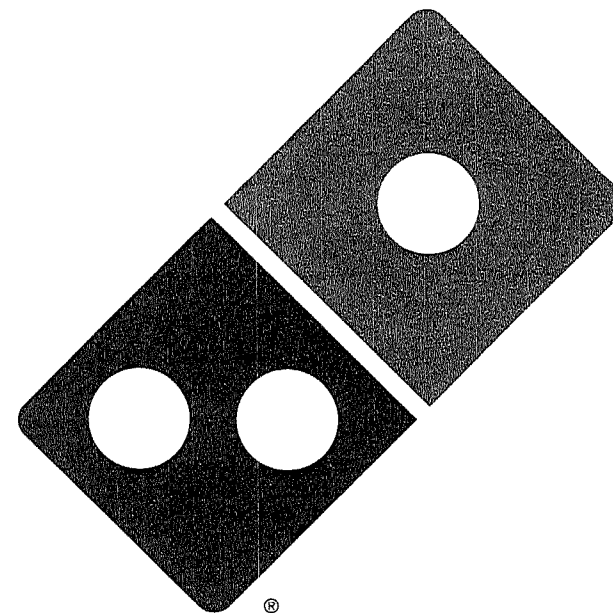
Concerts remain free to the public, thanks to the generosity of our supporters.
