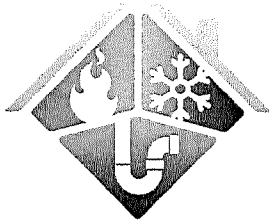

Mr. Kelley Ryan received a Bachelor of Music Degree from Muskingum College in 1975 and a Masters of Music Degree from the University of Akron in 1980. He has also studied at The University of Virginia, Kent State University, Ohio University, Andrews University and Ashland University. He has been an OMEA Adjudicator since 1981 and served as the OMEA District 9 treasurer for four years. More recently, he edited and revised the OMEA Required Solo lists for soprano, tenor, and baritone saxophones and for the Eb clarinet.

In August, Mr. Ryan will begin his 46th year directing bands for the Zanesville City School System where he teaches grades 5 through 12.

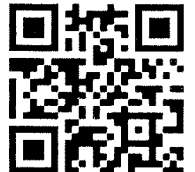
Making A Difference

Dr. David A. Turrill

ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

Dr. David A. Turrill was appointed Artistic Director of the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band in 2019. He also serves as Director of Bands and Associate Professor of Music at Muskingum University, where he conducts the Muskingum University Wind Ensemble, the Muskingum Valley Symphonic Winds, and co-directs the Jazz Ensemble. His teaching responsibilities at Muskingum include teaching applied trumpet, conducting, courses in music education, and supervising student teachers. In addition to teaching, Dr. Turrill also currently serves as coordinator of the music education program and chair of the music department. Dr. Turrill has maintained an active schedule as a guest conductor and clinician, and played trumpet in the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band from 2010 to 2018. A champion of new music, he has been involved in numerous commissioning projects, including works by composers John Mackey, Jake Runestad, Ryan Nowlin, Donald Grantham, Giovanni Santos, and Anthony Plog.

A native of Marietta, Ohio, Dr. Turrill earned the Bachelor of Music Education degree as well as Master of Music degrees in Conducting and Trumpet Performance from Ohio University. He earned the Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Trumpet Performance, with a cognate in wind conducting, from Michigan State University. Prior to his appointment at Muskingum, Dr. Turrill was on the faculty at Spring Arbor University (MI) and performed regularly with the orchestras of Lansing, Grand Rapids, West Michigan, Battle Creek, Saginaw Bay, Jackson, and Livonia.

In addition to his university teaching experience, Dr. Turrill also has twelve years of public-school teaching experience as an elementary, middle school, and high school band director. His middle school and high school bands consistently earned superior ratings at regional and state adjudicated events. Dr. Turrill's professional affiliations include membership in Pi Kappa Lambda music honor society, the College Band Directors National Association, the National Association for Music Education, the Ohio Music Education Association, International Trumpet Guild, the Ohio Private College Instrumental Conductors Association, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia.

Dr. Laura E. Schumann is the Music Director and Conductor of the Southeastern Ohio Symphony Orchestra (SEOSO) and Professor of Music at Muskingum University. She also performs extensively throughout the southeastern and central Ohio region as a one-woman band, Dr. Laura's Musical Adventures. She has numerous guest conducting appearances throughout the United States and internationally, and is a highly sought-after clinician for string programs in the region and throughout the state. Dr. Schumann has won several musical leadership awards including a proclamation from Ohio Governor John Kasich (2018); ASCAP Adventurous Programming Award (2001); YMCA/YWCA Women of Achievement Award (2001); International Musician of the Year Award (2004); Cambridge (OH) Heritage Award for Leadership in the community (2004); William Rainey Harper Award for Outstanding Scholarship at Muskingum College (2005); and many others. She is noted for her unique and original family/children's programs, incorporating differing musical styles, educational components, exciting visual and interactive concerts, and out-of-the-box contemporary yet sophisticated approach to programming and audience development.

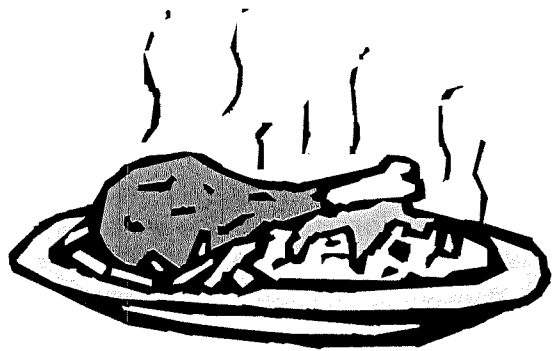

The ZCMB - A Brief History

Zanesville flourished with performing arts activities in the late 1800's, and the John Bauer Band was among them. The band was organized before 1800 and averaged 15 to 20 members. When the band leader died in 1912, his ensemble was taken over by the American Rolling Mills Company and became known as the Armco Band.

The 7th Regiment and Armco bands held their concerts locally, in McIntire Park and Putnam Park. By 1923, the two bands had merged, taking the present day name of Zanesville Memorial Concert Band.

Today, funds for the concerts are raised by individual and corporate contributions. An endowment fund has also been established for anyone wishing to make a donation towards the ZMCB.

The band's current home is Zane's Landing Park, along the eastern banks of the Muskingum River in downtown Zanesville. Concerts are performed on five Sunday evenings through the summer.

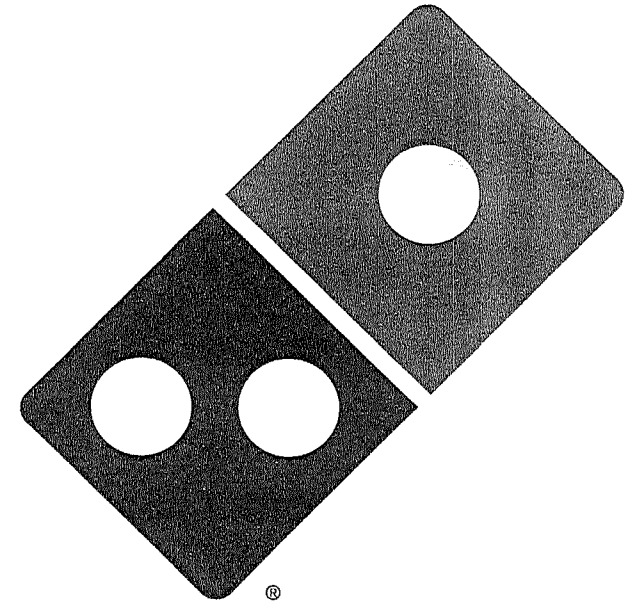
Concerts remain free to the public, thanks to the generosity of our supporters.
