**M**r. Ryan received a Bachelor of Music Degree from Muskingum College in 1975 and a Masters of Music Degree from the University of Akron in 1980. He has also studied at The University of Virginia, Kent State University, Ohio University, Andrews University and Ashland University. He has been an OMEA Adjudicator since 1981 and served as the OMEA District 9 treasurer for four years. More recently, he edited and revised the OMEA Required Solo lists for soprano, tenor, and baritone saxophones and for the Eb clarinet.

In August, Mr. Ryan will begin his 47th year directing bands for the Zanesville City School System where he teaches grades 5 through 12.

## **MEET OUR CONDUCTORS**

### **Dr. David A. Turrill**

#### **ARTISTIC DIRECTOR**

**D**r. David A. Turrill was appointed Artistic Director of the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band in 2019. He also serves as Director of Bands and Associate Professor of Music at Muskingum University, where he conducts the Muskingum University Wind Ensemble, the Muskingum Valley Symphonic Winds, and co-directs the Jazz Ensemble. His teaching responsibilities at Muskingum include teaching applied trumpet, conducting, courses in music education, and supervising student teachers. Dr. Turrill has maintained an active schedule as a guest conductor and clinician, and played trumpet in the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band from 2010 to 2018. A champion of new music, he has been involved in numerous commissioning projects, including works by composers John Mackey, Jake Runestad, Ryan Nowlin, Donald Grantham, Giovanni Santos, and Anthony Plog.

A native of Marietta, Ohio, Dr. Turrill earned the Bachelor of Music Education degree as well as Master of Music degrees in Conducting and Trumpet Performance from Ohio University. He earned the Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Trumpet Performance, with a cognate in wind conducting, from Michigan State University. Prior to his appointment at Muskingum, Dr. Turrill was on the faculty at Spring Arbor University (MI) and performed regularly with the orchestras of Lansing, Grand Rapids, West Michigan, Battle Creek, Saginaw Bay, Jackson, and Livonia.

In addition to his university teaching experience, Dr. Turrill also has twelve years of public-school teaching experience as an elementary, middle school, and high school band director. His middle school and high school bands consistently earned superior ratings at regional and state adjudicated events. Dr. Turrill's professional affiliations include membership in Pi Kappa Lambda music honor society, the College Band Directors National Association, the National Association for Music Education, the Ohio Music Education Association, International Trumpet Guild, the Ohio Private College Instrumental Conductors Association, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia.

## **MEET OUR GUEST DIRECTOR**

### **Slade Denman**

**S**lade Presley Denman is the Director of Bands and Assistant Professor of Music at the University of Pikeville, directing the Concert Band and Marching Band, overseeing the Jam Band and Jazz Band, and guiding the development of music education students. Prior to his time at UPike, Denman served as Professor of Instrumental Studies at Texas Wesleyan University, conducting the Wind Ensemble, Ram Band, and teaching courses in conducting and music education.

Before his graduate studies, Denman was the Director of Bands at Allen East Local School District located in Harrod, Ohio, where he spearheaded the district's first jazz band and piano laboratory program, served as assistant director in musical theater and show choir, and also led the 150-member Mustang Marching Brass into their tenth consecutive "Best-in-Show" prize during the annual "Kewpee Showcase of Bands", making them the winningest band in the history of the event.

Professor Denman is currently pursuing a Doctor of Musical Arts Degree in Wind Conducting at the University of North Texas, where he previously taught courses in undergraduate conducting, led the Concert and University Bands, and served as Teaching Fellow to the Green Brigade Marching Band and Pep Band. Denman received his Master and Bachelor of Music Education from Ohio University, where he worked extensively with the Ohio University Wind Symphony, Symphonic Band, University Band and "The Most Exciting Band in the Land" — the Ohio University Marching 110 — writing drill, arrangements, and facilitating rehearsals and events.

An accomplished conductor, pianist, and saxophonist, Denman continues to conduct and perform extensively and is an in-demand clinician, adjudicator, and guest conductor. He has professional affiliations with the College Band Directors National Association, the International Conductors Guild, the Kentucky Music Educators Association, New Horizons International Music Association, Kappa Kappa Psi, and the Midwest Clinic International Band, Orchestra and Music Conference.

## The ZCMB - A Brief History

Zanesville flourished with performing arts activities in the late 1800's, and the John Bauer Band was among them. The band was organized before 1800 and averaged 15 to 20 members. When the band leader died in 1912, his ensemble was taken over by the American Rolling Mills Company and became known as the Armco Band.

The 7th Regiment and Armco bands held their concerts locally, in McIntire Park and Putnam Park. By 1923, the two bands had merged, taking the present day name of Zanesville Memorial Concert Band.

Today, funds for the concerts are raised by individual and corporate contributions. An endowment fund has also been established for anyone wishing to make a donation towards the ZMCB.

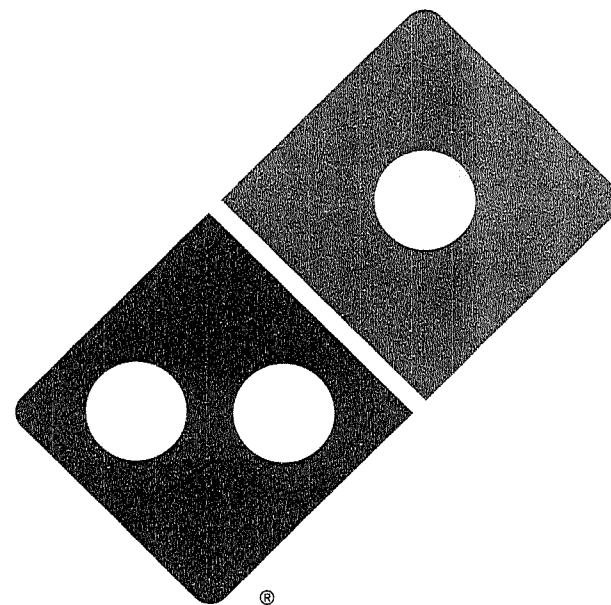
The band's current home is Zane's Landing Park, along the eastern banks of the Muskingum River in downtown Zanesville. Concerts are performed on five Sunday evenings through the summer.

Concerts remain free to the public, thanks to the generosity of our supporters.
