## ZMCB Artistic Director - Jeffrey L. Roquemore

Jeff retired after serving 16 years at Zanesville High School as band director and music department coordinator from 1988-2004. At ZHS, he was in charge of the concert band, wind ensemble, jazz band and pep band in addition to the marching band, which had an unbroken record of 16 appearances at state finals. Previously Jeff held band director positions at Philo HS, Hamlin (WVA) HS, Fort Frye HS, and most recently Custer County HS in Westcliffe, Colorado. He earned a Bachelors Degree at Ohio University in 1974, a Masters Degree in Music Education at Marshall University in 1981, and a Masters Degree in Public School Administration at Ohio University in 1992. He has served the Ohio Music Education Association (OMEA) as district secretary/treasurer, president-elect, and president; hosting high school large group, middle school solo & ensemble, regional orchestra, local marching band, and district honor band/choir events. His professional organizations include: OMEA, American School Band Directors Association, Phi Beta Mu, Omicron Delta Kappa, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. Jeff was director of the Muskingum College Spirit Band 2004-2006. He resides in Dresden with his wife, Jennifer.

## Guest Conductor/Composer – Barry E. Kopetz

**Barry E. Kopetz** is Director of Bands and Professor of Conducting at Capital University. His conducting responsibilities include the Symphonic Winds, the Wind Symphony and Chamber Winds. Kopetz holds a doctorate with distinction from the School of Music at Indiana University. He has studied with Frederick Fennell, Frederick Ebbs and Professor Ray Cramer of Indiana University, and Dr. Donald McGinnis of Ohio State University.

Kopetz is active as a composer and arranger, with more than eighty published works to his credit. He has written numerous commissioned works, and has composed music for both chamber and large ensembles, as well as for television and film. He is in demand as a guest conductor/ composer, and accepts a limited number of engagements each year with All-State and Honor Bands. He is also a published author, having written interpretive articles regarding the standard repertoire for The Instrumentalist Magazine. He has been selected for an award from the Educational Press Association of America for these interpretive analyses.

In 1997, Kopetz was selected as “Utah Music Educator of the Year” by the Utah Music Education Association for his work contributing to the growth and quality of the instrumental music programs in the state of Utah. He is a member of the National Band Association, College Band Directors National Association, Music Educators National Conference, Pi Kappa Lambda, Phi Beta Mu, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, and Kappa Kappa Psi. He was selected for membership into the prestigious American Bandmasters Association in 1998.

Kopetz resides in Gahanna, Ohio, with his wife. He has two grown daughters, and his hobbies include reading, Civil War History, Presidential History, composing, and restoring classic Mustangs.

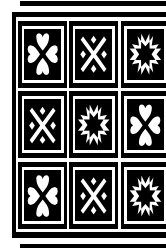
