The ZMCB – A Brief History

Zanesville flourished with performing arts activities in the late 1800s, and the John Bauer Band was among them. The band was organized before 1880 and averaged 15 to 20 members. When the band leader died in 1912, his ensemble was taken over by the American Rolling Mills Company, and became known as the Armco Band.

The 7th Regiment Band was formed in 1900, conducted by Bruce Tomlinson. Four years later, band members began federal service in advent of war.

The 7th Regiment and Armco bands held their concerts locally, in McIntire Park and Putnam Park. By 1923, the two bands had merged, taking the present day name of Zanesville Memorial Concert Band.

Today, funds for the concerts are raised by individual and corporate contributions. An endowment fund has also been established for anyone wishing to make a donation towards the ZMCB.

The band's current home is Zane's Landing Park, along the eastern banks of the Muskingum River in downtown Zanesville. Concerts are performed on five Sunday evenings through the summer.

Concerts remain free to the public, thanks to the generosity of our supporters.

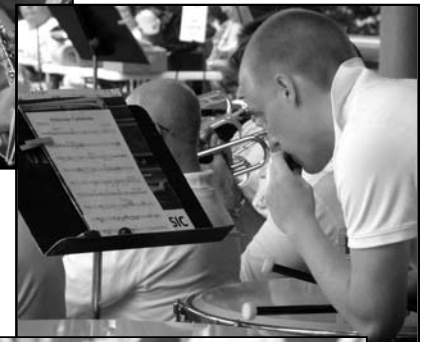

He also plays flute and piccolo for the band.

Mrs. Schmelzer Bock is a native of Bremen, Ohio, and received her Bachelor of Music Education and Master of the Arts degrees from Ohio State University. As a member of the Ohio State University Marching Band, she became the first woman to dot the "i" in the famed "Script Ohio" marching maneuver in a single-script at a home football game in Ohio Stadium. Schmelzer Bock also has been a member of the 122nd Army Band / Army National Guard, stationed at Beitler Armory in Worthington. 

1st Lt. Ryan J. Nowlin, U.S.M.C.

Assistant Director, "The President's Own" United States Marine Band

First Lieutenant Ryan J. Nowlin joined "The President's Own" United States Marine Band in August 2010 as a staff arranger. He was appointed Assistant Director and commissioned a first lieutenant in July 2014. With "The President's Own," 1st Lt. Nowlin has arranged and composed a variety of selections for the Marine Band, Marine Chamber Orchestra, brass quintet, and various other small ensembles. His music has been performed at the White House, in the Washington, D.C., metropolitan area, across the country during the band's annual concert tour, at the Midwest Band & Orchestra Clinic in Chicago, and at the National Association for Music Education's Music Education Week in Baltimore. As an arranger for the Marine Band, 1st Lt. Nowlin has created original arrangements of "America" and the National Anthem for performance at the 2013 Presidential Inauguration and Johann Sebastian Bach's Toccata and Fugue in D minor, which was featured on the 2013 Marine Band recording, *From the Keyboard*. He has served as a conductor for the fall and winter Chamber Music Series and the band's Conductor Training Program in 2013. He was nominated for his current position in 2014. 1st Lt. Nowlin's early music instruction was on the piano and French horn. Upon graduating in 1996 from North Royalton High School, he attended Bowling Green State University, where he earned a bachelor's degree in music education in 2000 and a master's degree in music education and conducting in 2004. He studied with Herbert Spencer and Bruce Moss at BGSU, as well as prolific composer Anne McGinty. Prior to joining "The President's Own," 1st Lt. Nowlin was an instructor at BGSU and served as a staff arranger for the BGSU Falcon Marching Band. Additionally, he was an instructor at BGSU, where he taught band arranging, conducting, and was the assistant director of athletic bands. He was an instrumental music teacher for 10 years serving as an assistant band director at Jackson City Schools in Ohio, and most recently was the director of bands at Brecksville-Broadview Heights School District. In addition to his duties with "The President's Own," 1st Lt. Nowlin has appeared as a conductor and clinician with several ensembles to include the Kansas State University Wind Ensemble and Chorus; the Capital University Honors Wind Ensemble; the Indiana University-Purdue University Fort Wayne Wind Ensemble; and the Defiance College Community Band.
