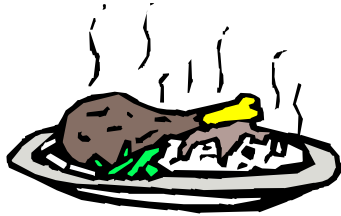

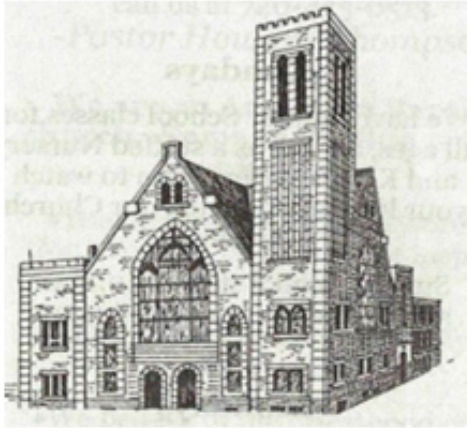

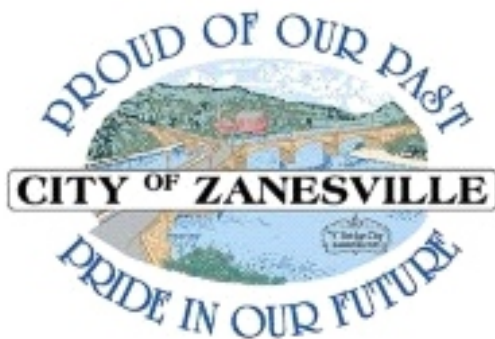

MEET OUR ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

Dr. David A. Turrill

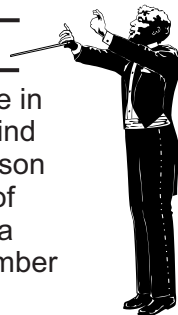
Dr. David A. Turrill has served as the Artistic Director of the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band since 2019. He is currently Associate Professor of Music and Director of Bands at Muskingum University, where he has taught since 2010. His work at Muskingum includes conducting the Wind Ensemble and the Muskingum Valley Symphonic Winds, in addition to teaching courses in music education, conducting, and music theory. He also serves as the Faculty Coordinator for the Muskingum First Year Experience.

A native of Marietta, Ohio, he earned a Bachelor of Music in music education from Ohio University; a Master of Music in conducting and trumpet performance from Ohio University; and a Doctor of Musical Arts in trumpet performance, with a cognate in wind conducting, from Michigan State University. Prior to joining the faculty at Muskingum, Dr. Turrill taught at Spring Arbor University (MI) and enjoyed twelve years of public-school teaching in southeastern Ohio. Bands under his direction consistently earned superior ratings at regional and state adjudicated events. He is passionate about new repertoire for wind ensemble and has been involved in the commissioning of works by leading composers, including Brian Balmages, Ryan Nowlin, John Mackey, Jake Runestad, Donald Grantham, and Giovanni Santos.

Dr. Turrill's professional affiliations include membership in Pi Kappa Lambda music honor society, National Association for Music Education, Ohio Music Education Association, Ohio Private College Instrumental Conductors Association, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. He is active as a band clinician for high schools in the region and has presented at the state professional development conferences of Ohio and Iowa.

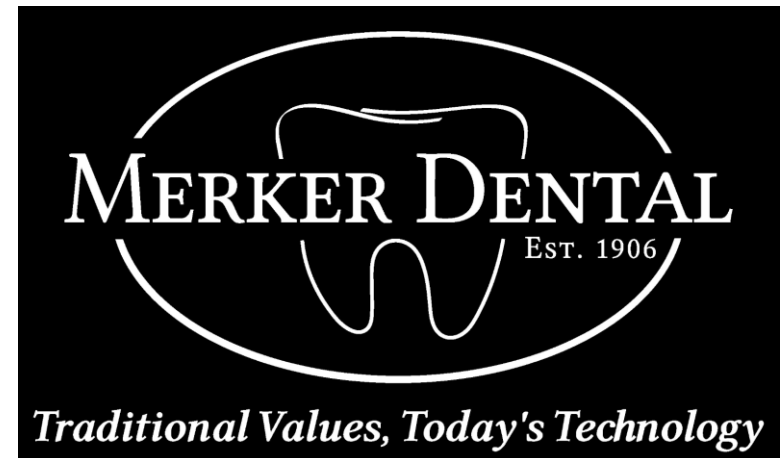

MEET OUR HONORS BAND DIRECTOR

April Linard

April Linard is currently completing her 19th year in education. She is currently in her 3rd year as band director at Claymont City Schools. Prior to her time at Claymont, she completed 16 years as band director at Union Local Schools. At Union Local, she was the co-director for theatre and was the director of bands for grades 5-12 where she led the marching band to OMEA State Finals in 2016 for the first time in school history and then again in 2017 & 2019. She was selected to direct the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference All Star Marching Band in 2009 and has had multiple students chosen to participate in the Macy's Great American Marching Band in New York City for over a decade. April is a member of the National Association for Music Education and the Ohio Music Educators Association where she served as OMEA President-Elect for District 9 in 2021-2022 and currently serves as a marching band and solo & ensemble adjudicator. April received her Masters degree in Music Education from Kent State University and her Bachelors degree in Music Education from Malone University.

MEET OUR ASSISTANT DIRECTOR

Kelley Ryan

Kelley Ryan has served as the Assistant Director of the Zanesville Memorial Concert Band since 2016. In 2024, after completing 48 years of directing bands, he retired from the Zanesville City Schools where he had taught grades 5 through 12. Mr. Ryan received a Bachelor of Music Degree from Muskingum College in 1975 and a Master of Music Degree from the University of Akron in 1980. He has also studied at the University of Virginia, Kent State University, Ohio University, Andrews University, and Ashland University. He has been an OMEA adjudicator since 1981 and served as the OMEA District IX treasurer for four years. More recently, he edited and revised the OMEA required solo lists for soprano, tenor, and baritone saxophones and for the Eb clarinet.
